APPLICATION TO GRANT A PREMISES LICENCE
WINTERTON COMMUNITY PAVILION, NEWPORT DRIVE, WINTERTON,
NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE, DN15 9ST**

1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

- 1.1 To request that the Sub-Committee determines the application to grant a Premises Licence for the Winterton Community Pavilion.
- 1.2 There has been one representation, in the form of a Petition with 29 signatures, which has been deemed relevant. This is detailed in paragraph 4.2. A copy of the representation is attached to this report at Appendix C.

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2.1 In accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 and the council's scheme of delegation, all applications for a licence where a relevant representation has been made need to be determined by this Sub-Committee.
- 2.2 When determining the application the Sub-Committee should only consider issues which relate to the four licensing objectives. The licensing objectives are:
 - The prevention of Crime and Disorder
 - Public Safety
 - The prevention of a Public Nuisance
 - The protection of Children from Harm
- 2.3 Members of the Sub-Committee must have regard to the statutory 'Statement of Licensing Policy'. Members of the Sub-Committee may deviate from the statutory guidance and licensing policy only if they deem that there is good reason to do so.
- 2.4 Members of the Sub-Committee should not allow themselves to pre-determine the application or to be prejudiced in favour or opposed to the licence and shall only determine the application having had an opportunity to consider all relevant facts. Members of the Sub-Committee should not hear or decide on any applications for premises licences in their own ward.

- 2.5 Members of the Sub-Committee shall remember that they are acting in a quasi-judicial role in determining the application and shall remain in the room so that they hear all the evidence before determining the application. The determination shall be based on the evidence provided, which is relevant to the licensing objectives.
- 2.6 The options available to the Sub-Committee having considered all the relevant information are as follows:
- To refuse to grant the licence
 - To grant the licence with additional conditions
 - To grant the licence without additional conditions
 - To grant the licence but restrict the licensable activities
 - To grant the licence with restricted times
- 2.7 Members of the Sub-Committee should be advised that the applicant, statutory consultees and persons making relevant representations may appeal to the Magistrates Court within 21 days of the date on which they were notified of the decision.

3. ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3.1 The application for the grant of the Premises Licence for Winterton Community Pavilion was received on 27 August 2013. A copy of the application is attached to the report at Appendix A. The nature of the grant application is as follows:

Provision of licensable activities and the Supply of alcohol Monday to Sunday 10:00 hrs 23:00 hrs. The opening hours Monday to Sunday 09:00 hrs to 23:30 hrs.

- 3.2 There has been 1 objection received in the form of a petition from interested parties, this consists of 29 signatures and has been deemed relevant. This is detailed in paragraph 4.2 and is attached to this report as Appendix C.
- 3.3 The applicant has been made aware of the representation.

- 4.1 An applicant for a Premises Licence has to serve a copy of the application form and a plan of the premises on the statutory consultees within 48 hours of the Licensing Authority receiving its copy.

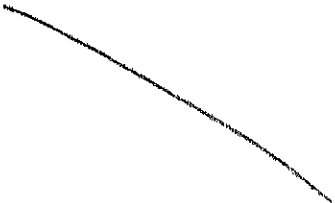

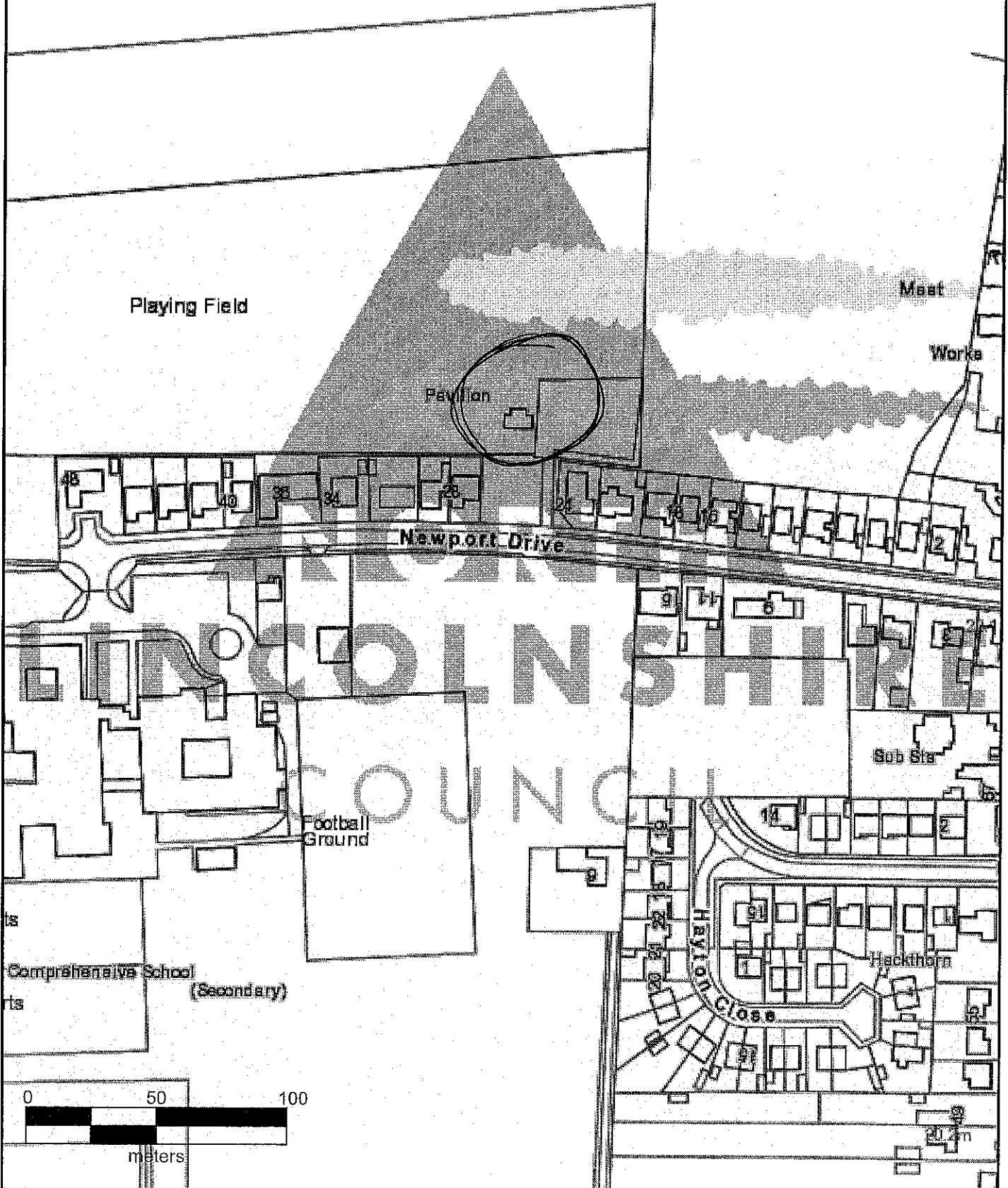

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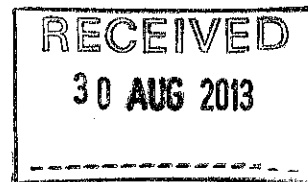

It is clear that all of the above points need serious consideration and a full Police report and review on the potential crime related issues, along with the full involvement of each resident that has signed the petition.



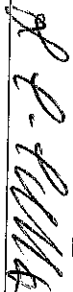
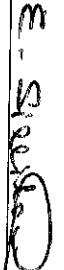
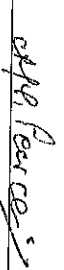





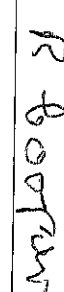
