

## ENFORCEMENT UPDATE – 22 July 2009

Site	Breach of Planning Control	Action
Land off Moor Lane, Messingham	Change of use of land to equestrian purposes, siting of metal container and field shelter, erection of exercise ring and laying of hardstanding as car park	Planning permission refused 7 April 2008 (2008/0046), enforcement notices issued, appeals lodged against refusal of planning permission and both notices, public inquiry held 9 June 2009, both notices quashed and planning permission granted unconditionally
50 Long Road, Scunthorpe	Kennels erected within curtilage of dwelling house without planning permission	Planning permission refused on 4 March 2008 under 2007/1959 – no appeal. Enforcement notice issued, appeal dismissed, notice upheld, kennels still not removed (or altered so as to make them permitted development), prosecution to be brought
Building site off Staindale Road, Scunthorpe (Brat Hill Farm)	Hoarding sign mounted on top of site cabin	Consent to retain advertisement refused on 17 October 2008 under 2008/1233, appeal against refusal of consent dismissed on 25 March 2009, sign now removed
Land to the rear of 3 Perseverance Terrace, Oxmarsh Lane, New Holland	Non-compliance with EN96 requiring removal of caravan, extension and wooden awning	Prosecution heard at Grimsby Crown Court at request of defendant. Guilty plea, fined £400 and costs of £200 to be paid at £20 per month. Caravan, extension/wooden awning still to be removed. Further prosecution or default action to be considered.
