SLATE FEST, SLATE HOUSE FARM, HOLME LANE, HOLME, DN16 3RE**

1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

- 1.1 To request that the Sub-Committee determines the application for a Premises Licence for 'Slate House Farm', attached as Appendix A to this report.
- 1.2 There have been 3 representations, which have been deemed relevant. This is detailed in paragraph 4.2 and are attached to this report as Appendix B.

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2.1 In accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 and the council's scheme of delegation, all applications for a licence where a relevant representation has been made need to be determined by this Sub-Committee.
- 2.2 When determining the application, the Sub-Committee should only consider issues, which relate to the four licensing objectives. The licensing objectives are:
 - The prevention of Crime and Disorder
 - Public Safety
 - The prevention of a Public Nuisance
 - The protection of Children from Harm
- 2.3 Members of the Sub-Committee must have regard to the statutory guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003 and our Statement of Licensing Policy. Members of the Sub-Committee may deviate from the statutory guidance and licensing policy only if they deem that there is good reason to do so.
- 2.4 Members of the Sub-Committee should not allow themselves to pre-determine the application or to be prejudiced in favour or opposed to the licence and shall only determine the application having had an opportunity to consider all relevant facts. Members of the Sub-Committee should not hear or decide on any applications for premises licences in their own ward.

2.5 Members of the Sub-Committee shall remember that they are acting in a quasi-judicial role in determining the application and shall remain in the room so that they hear all the evidence before determining the application. The determination shall be based on the evidence provided which is relevant to the licensing objectives.

2.6 The options available to the Sub-Committee having considered all the relevant information are as follows:

- To refuse to grant the licence
- To grant the licence with additional conditions
- To grant the licence without additional conditions
- To grant the licence but restrict the licensable activities
- To grant the licence with restricted times

2.7 Members of the Sub-Committee should be advised that the applicant, statutory consultees and persons making relevant representations may appeal to the Magistrates Court within 21 days of the date on which they were notified of the decision.

3. ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

3.1 The application for a premises licence for 'Slate House Farm' was received on 15 May 2014. A copy of the application is attached to the report at Appendix A. The nature of the application is as follows:

The site is currently licensed for the running of car boots on Saturday and Sunday. Obviously, on this particular Saturday, the car boot would not run. It is a 10 acre site, within which there is an enclosed, covered area (open barn scenario). I propose to operate a bar from this enclosed area as it would make it easier to make sure that anyone buying alcohol is not under 18. Under 18's would not be able to enter this area (which will be manned by our recognisable officials). As a further security measure, all members of the public entering the event will be issued with a colour coded wrist band. Under 18's will wear an easily identifiable coloured wrist band. In addition we will have an identifiable security team on site for the whole time.





Re Premises Licence – Slate Fest, Holme Lane, Holme, DN16 3RE

Holme Parish residents object to the application for a Premises Licence at Slate House Farm. We strongly feel that the application is inappropriate for this location.

Slate House Farm already runs a car boot event on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holiday Mondays. This event is scheduled to take place on a Saturday. Is the proposal to run it instead of the car boot on that day or in conjunction with it?

There is already excessive traffic using this country lane to attend the car boot and we feel that the lane is completely inappropriate for further increased traffic, particularly at night. The congestion would result in possible accidents due to the entrance/exit being next to a sharp bend and a potential for dangerous driving following drinking from 2pm until 11pm. There is no public transport available which could result in a drink driving problem. Holme Lane has no street lighting, a poor road surface and no footpaths so any pedestrians walking at night from the event are at a high risk from falls and being in direct contact with vehicles.

Holme Parish is a quiet rural area and we do not want these types of events promoted in the area. We feel that this would lead to further applications for future regular events as happened with the car boot sales.

If the event is well attended there would be a need for police presence either for road congestion and crowd control.

With today's social media theses events can attract many more people than anticipated which could also lead to local disruption and people camping, parking problems, noise, litter and hygiene issues. Although the site is on open farmland, as the crow flies it is also very close to Messingham and Bottesford (are these councils aware of the application?) Many years ago an illegal rave was organised in Twigmoor woods and the deep bass sound travelled for miles. The open farmland also means this type of event would be detrimental to wildlife. Slate House have planning permission to turn the derelict barn into a home and they had to go through rigorous monitoring on owls and bats before they were granted planning permission. The site is used only as a business enterprise at present with the owners living outside the parish and we welcomed their application to change the barn to residential and would welcome them into the parish community however we cannot see how this type of event would have any benefit to our quiet countryside parish.

Thank you for your consultation regarding the above application. This department has the following comments to make in respect of this matter.

There is the potential for noise from this event to impact upon sensitive residential receptors therefore being mindful of the prevention of public nuisance licensing objective, this department objects to this application unless the following conditions are attached to the premises license.

All residential properties in close proximity to the premises shall be informed of this event in writing 28 days prior to the event taking place; the information shall be as follows.

- *Date of event*
- *Start and Finish time (that shall be adhered to)*
- *Contact telephone number (for resident to contact with any concerns during the event)*
- *A record shall be kept of any complaints including details of what action was taken.*

Noise levels shall be monitored at the closest residential property to ensure noise levels are acceptable during the event. A record shall be kept of all monitoring.
