REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

- 1.1 To update Council on the review of polling districts and polling places and on the consultation carried out and to make recommendations in respect of the review.

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2.1 The Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 introduced a change to the timing of compulsory reviews of UK parliamentary polling districts and polling places. It stated that the next compulsory review must be completed by 31 January 2015. Subsequent compulsory reviews must be started and completed within the period of 16 months that starts on 1 October or every 5 year after 1 October 2013.
- 2.2 A Public Notice was placed in a local newspaper and on the council's website giving notice of the review. In addition, further information about the review was also published on the council's website. In addition, specific consultations were undertaken with members of the council, political parties, other elected representatives such as members of parliament and members of the European Parliament and town and parish councils.
- 2.3 The formal consultation period ran from 7 August to 30 September 2014.

3. OPTIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3.1 The report outlines proposed revisions to a number of polling districts and polling places in North Lincolnshire.
- 3.2 However it should be recognised that following council approval of the proposals it may be necessary for the Returning Officer to approve changes to polling places depending on circumstances. For example where polling places are no longer available for reasons beyond our

control e.g. closure of buildings etc. In such circumstances he will consult with local ward members.

4. ANALYSIS OF OPTIONS

- 4.1 An analysis of the options is incorporated in appendix 1 attached to the report.

5. RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS (FINANCIAL, STAFFING, PROPERTY, IT)

5.1 Financial

There are no financial implications associated with the review of polling districts and polling places.

5.2 Staffing

There are no staffing implications associated with this report.

5.3 Property

There may be some property implications in relation to the report where it has been identified that alternative polling places are required.

5.4 IT

There are no IT implications associated with this report.

6 OUTCOMES OF INTEGRATED IMPACT ASSESSMENT (IF APPLICABLE)

- 6.1 The review of polling districts and polling places is a compulsory statutory requirement arising out of the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013. Its impact has been assessed nationally and therefore at a local level it is not necessary to carry out an integrated impact assessment.

7 OUTCOMES OF CONSULTATION AND CONFLICTS OF INTERESTS DECLARED

- 7.1 Feedback from polling station inspectors and polling station staff used at the European elections in May 2014 as regards location/suitability etc of polling stations. These have been analysed and incorporated into the process.
- 7.2 The chairman and agent for the Brigg and Goole Conservative Association has made a number of comments about the consistency of provision of polling stations in polling districts across the area and these

have where appropriate been taken into account and incorporated in the proposals.

7.3 The Secretary to the Labour Group has made a number of recommendations in respect of polling districts within North Lincolnshire and these have where appropriate been taken into account and incorporated into the proposals.

8 RECOMMENDATIONS

8.1 That the responses to the consultation on the review of polling districts and polling place be noted and that the recommendations set out in appendix 1 to the report be approved.
