SCHOOL GOVERNORS – INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

1.1 To consider approving a revised Instrument of Government for Baysgarth School – A Specialist Technology College to be effective from 17 November 2009.

1.2 The key points in this report are as follows:

- On 29 September 2009 the governing body gave their approval to the replacement of Jeff Teasdale Ltd as sponsor governor to C Spencer Ltd
- The governing body has submitted a new Instrument of Government to be effective from 17 November 2009.

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2.1 Baysgarth School – A Specialist Technology College governing body has submitted a new Instrument of Government for approval.

3. OPTIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

3.1 One option available is to approve the new Instrument of Government (as attached at Appendix A). This would ensure that the Instrument complied with the recommendations of the governing body.

3.2 The other option would be not to approve the new Instrument. This decision would go against the recommendations of the governing body.

4. ANALYSIS OF OPTIONS

4.1 If the new Instrument was approved the Instrument of Government would reflect the change in the second sponsor for the college.

4.2 If the new Instrument was not approved the Instrument of Government would not reflect the change in sponsor.

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

- 1 The name of the school is Baysgarth School – A Specialist Technology College.
- 2 The school is a community school.
- 3 The name of the governing body is “the governing body of Baysgarth School – A Specialist Technology College”.
- 4 The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) 7 x parent governors;
 - (b) 4 x LEA governors;
 - (c) 4 x staff governors;
 - (d) 5 x community governors;
 - (e) 2 x sponsor governors:
1 sponsor reserved for Kimberley Clark and 1 sponsor reserved for C Spencer Limited – nominations to be received from sponsors for governors to consider
- 5 Total number of governors 20 + 2 sponsor governors.
- 6 This Instrument of government comes into effect 17 November 2009.
- 7 This Instrument was made by order of North Lincolnshire Local Education Authority in November 2009.
- 8 A copy of the Instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor).
