APPOINTMENT OF LOCAL AUTHORITY SCHOOL GOVERNORS

1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

1.1 To consider appointing persons to serve as LEA governors.

1.2 The key points in this report are as follows:

- The school governing bodies listed (appendix A) have LEA vacancies
- The reasons for these vacancies are also listed (appendix A)

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2.1 There are currently 40 LEA school governor vacancies. This equates to 18% of the total number of LEA governors.

3. OPTIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

3.1 One option would be to appoint persons on the waiting list for their chosen school (appendix B).

3.2 The other option would be not to appoint the persons named on the waiting list.

4. ANALYSIS OF OPTIONS

4.1 If the persons on the waiting list were appointed to their chosen school this would fill the individual governing body vacancies and reduce the total number within North Lincolnshire.

4.2 If the persons on the waiting list were not appointed to their chosen school this would neither fill the individual governing body vacancies nor reduce the total number within North Lincolnshire.
