North Lincolnshire Community Safety Plan 2018/20

1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

- 1.1 As part of the Council's Policy Framework within the Council Constitution the Council is required to approve and adopt the Crime and Disorder Reduction Strategy.
- 1.2 In North Lincolnshire the Crime and Disorder Reduction Strategy is published as the Community Safety Plan. The Plan has been prepared and approved by the Community Safety Partnership.

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2.1 The North Lincolnshire Community Safety Partnership has a statutory requirement to set out a Crime and Disorder Reduction Strategy known locally as the Annual Community Safety Plan and to monitor its progress. The Plan gives an overview of Crime and Disorder in North Lincolnshire and sets out the Partnerships key priorities and work program for 2018/20
- 2.2 The Plan for 2018 sets out the outcomes to be achieved and actions against three key priorities
 - **Safe – people feel safe and are safe**
 - **Strong – people take responsibility for their community**
 - **Resilient – people recover and withstand adverse impact**
- 2.3 The plan was devised thorough consultation and as a result of the Annual Joint Strategic Intelligence Assessment (JSIA) and is complimentary to the North Lincolnshire Council Strategy and contributes to the delivery of the agreed Council Outcomes. The Plan also contributes to the delivery of the Police and Crime Plan for Humberside.
- 2.4 The Community Safety Partnership was reviewed in 2018 and has consistent and strong leadership from the 6 Statutory Partners. The Council is represented by the Director of Children and Community Resilience and the Council contributes to the strategic groups and delivery plans through a wide range of staff across the whole Council.

3. KEY PRIORITIES

- 3.1 The three priorities all have measurable outcomes and performance indicators as well as priority actions which are all detailed in the plan

3.2 The Plan is set out over two years 2018 – 2020 but will be reviewed annually in 2019 against the findings of the Joint Strategic Intelligence Assessment and will be updated as required in 2019.
