By 'Special Urgency' – In accordance with the requirements of the above Regulations, the Chair of the relevant Scrutiny Panel has been informed about the aforementioned key decision and has agreed that the matter is urgent because a public consultation period ending on 4 October 2020 requires a decision on PSPO continuity before expiry of the current order on 10 October 2020, and this cannot reasonably be deferred.
